Climate Economic Analysis for Development, Investment, and Resilience

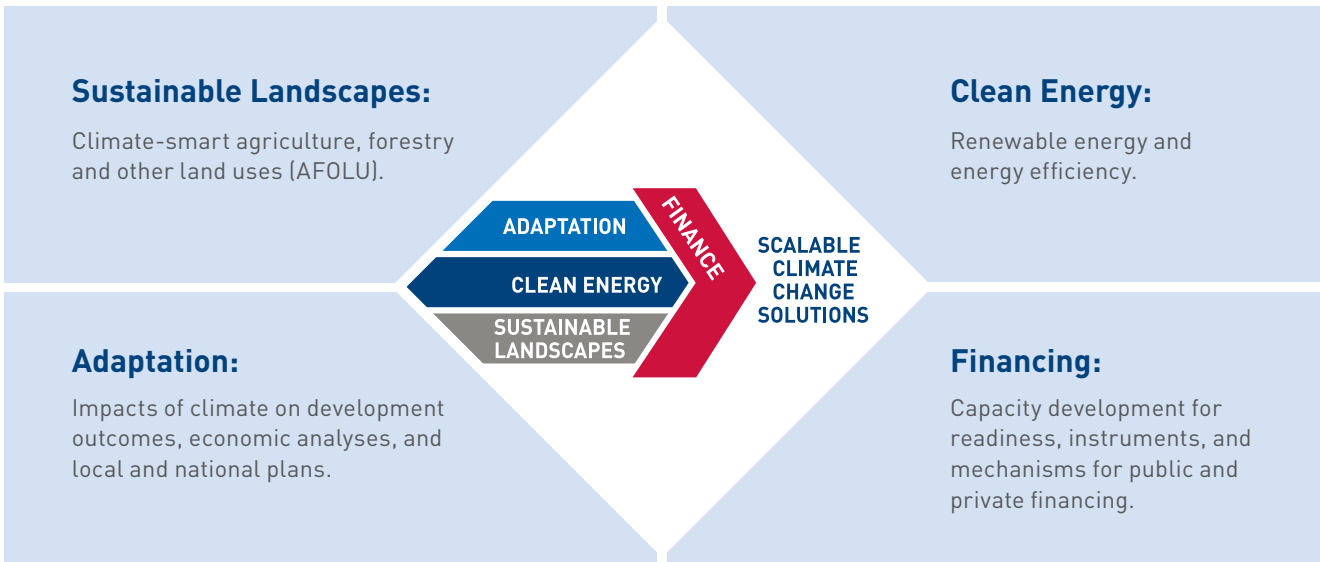
The USAID-funded Climate Economic Analysis for Development, Investment, and Resilience (CEADIR) Activity helps governments, private companies, and civil society organizations make the business and economic case for investing in clean energy, sustainable landscapes, and climate adaptation and resilience. CEADIR provides support for financial and economic analysis, planning, and policy analysis to help partner countries assess, finance, and scale up sustainable development strategies and practices. CEADIR also provides technical assistance to help mobilize financing from private and public sources.

## Collaboration and Focus

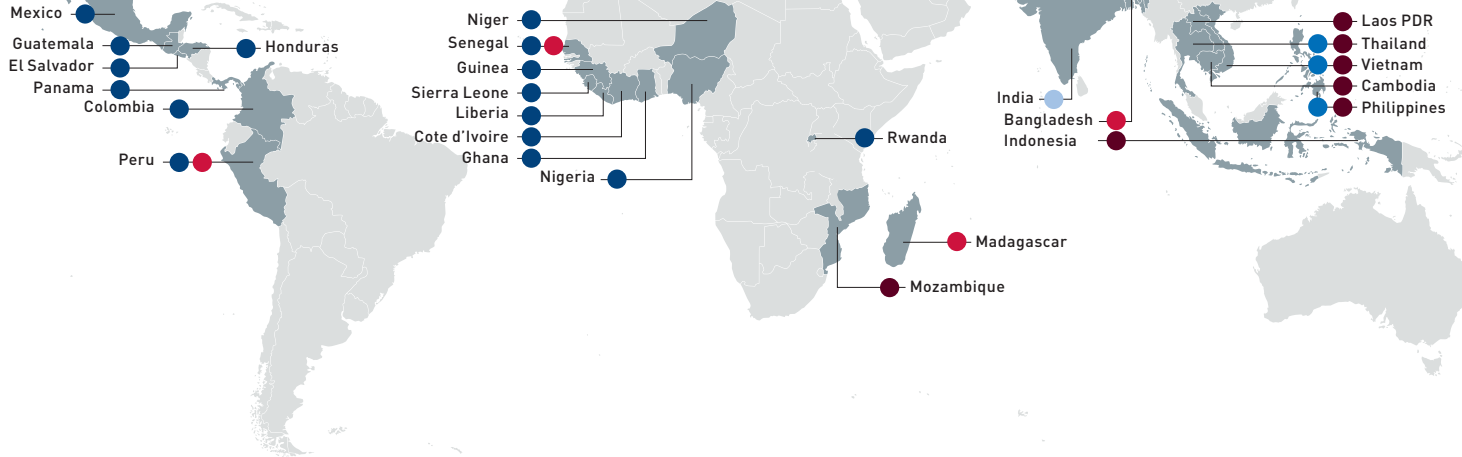
CEADIR is managed by the Global Climate Change (GCC) and Economic Policy (EP) Offices of the Economic Growth, Education, and Environment (E3) Bureau. This global project can assist national and subnational governments, local communities, NGOs, and private sector businesses in all USAID-assisted countries. The funding ceiling is over \$20.1 million. CEADIR's work is funded by central resources and buy-ins from USAID missions and other operating units. CEADIR's period of performance extends to March 29, 2019.
