CASE STUDY: TRAINING ETHIOPIA'S PUBLIC PROCUREMENT STAFF /

In recent years Ethiopia's public procurement has undergone a number of reforms, including procurement being decentralised to regional and urban administrations.

The Federal Public Procurement and Property Administration Agency (FPPA) contracted Crown Agents to provide training and support for their procurement staff, with the objective that they become fully qualified and certified in their new roles. Our experts started by reviewing the existing procurement competency frameworks to establish different levels of aptitude amongst employees, and to set the standards required. Crown Agents developed a comprehensive training package, including certification programmes covering essential, advanced and specialist levels. Train the Trainer courses were also rolled out to enhance the capacity of the local staff. Our programme has succeeded to ensure that thousands of procurement professionals across Ethiopia are fully trained, qualified and certified as strong public procurement professionals.

CASE STUDY: OPERATIONAL HEALTH PROCUREMENT UNDER SOUTH SUDAN'S HEALTH POOLED FUND 2 (HPF2) /

Working under DFID's HPF programme since 2012, we have managed a consortium of partners and been responsible for the health fund management. The ultimate aim of the project is to

provide the people of South Sudan with the provision of quality health care.

In 2015 under HPF2, we were given the additional role of being the Ministry of Health's official procurement agent, whereby we undertook the quarterly procurement of much needed health products, in addition to arranging logistics, storage and distribution. In 2017, we delivered 17 million emergency drugs to over 1000 health centres to 8 out of the 10 states in South Sudan.

Liaising closely with the Ministry of Health and using our experience and expertise, we proactively sought to apply further efficiencies to the procurement and supply chain. By embedding a strategic logistics plan into our procurement plan, we managed to

drive down delivery consignments from 41 to 5, whilst still procuring the full quantity of goods required.

Prior to our role as a procurement agent, South Sudan often suffered health product shortages due to unaligned procurement and a fragmented supply chain. Since taking on our role under HPF2, we have not only driven down delivery costs on a quarter by quarter basis but also reduced transit times from 9 to 2 weeks. Most significantly, we have seen 98%-100% of goods arrive in South Sudan on time and in full.

CASE STUDY: CONDUCTING ROAD BID EVALUATIONS IN UGANDA /

From 2012 to 2015, Crown Agents supported the Uganda Government to carry out reform of their road sector. Working with Uganda's National Roads Authority [UNRA], we supported their procurement process in a number of ways.

Firstly, we reviewed their bidding documents, then gave feedback for considerations and improvement that ultimately resulted in the submission of high quality proposals, ensuring a solid foundation from the start of the procurement process. Central to our role under this project was to undertake the evaluations of bids on behalf of UNRA. We evaluated 130 bids for Works and Services in relation to the purchasing of road infrastructure. Our value add was to achieve the greatest transparency and ensure fair competition amongst bidders. As a result of our inputs, zero governmental administrative reviews were required on the procurement that we assisted with, compared to the five reviews that were undertaken during the previous year prior to our involvement.
